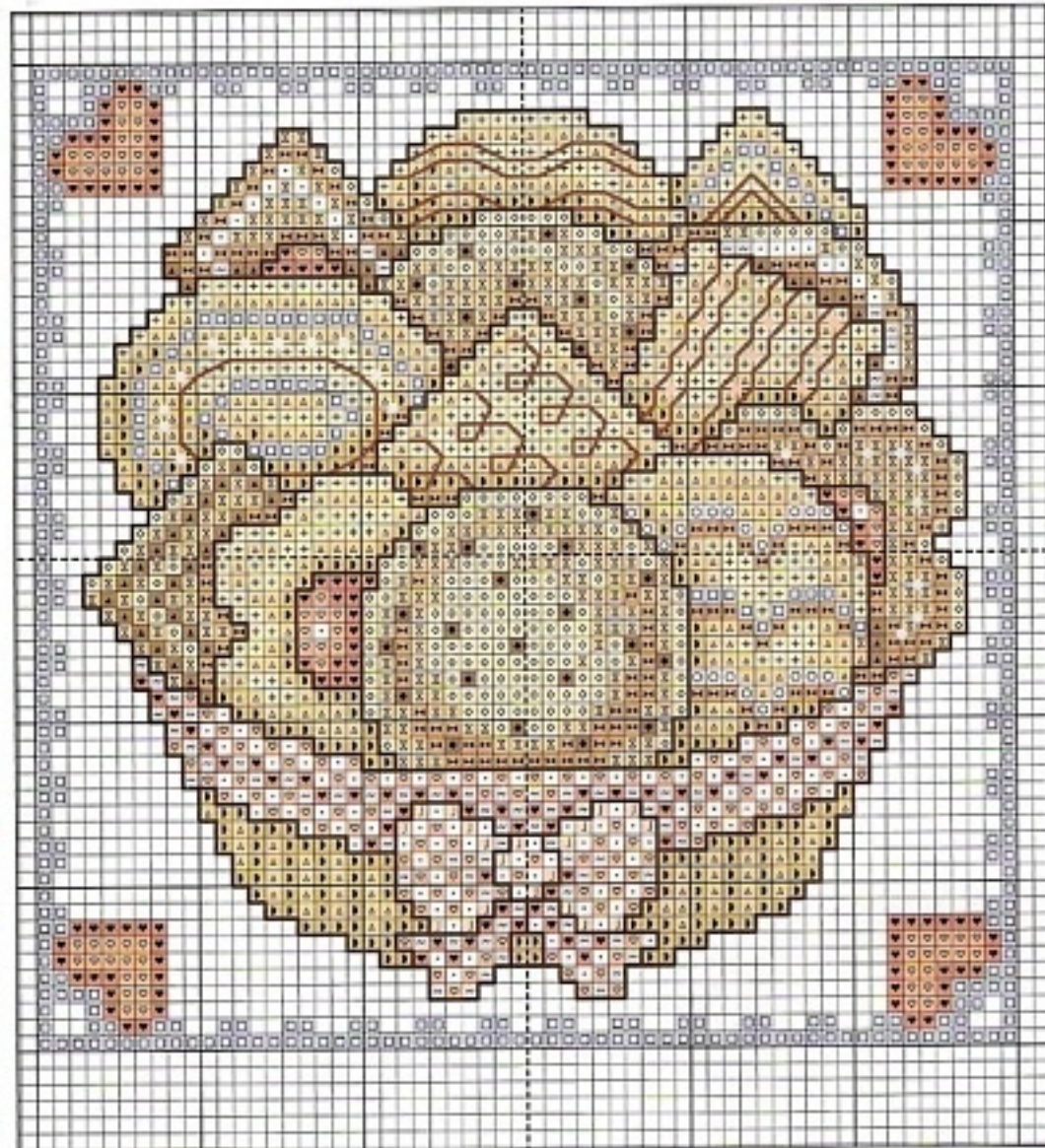

### ► Good enough to eat!

This gorgeous cookie basket is filled with all kinds of treats – but which one to eat first...?



## How to make this...

Stitch the cookie basket on white 14HPI aida, then trim and fray neatly. Back with white card then attach to a square of red card with 3D foam pads. Punch holes in the corners of the card and thread through the red gingham ribbon. Attach the red card onto thick white card and stick down the ribbon on the corners. Mount into a frame and finish with ribbon bows on each corner. This pretty natural wood frame complements the browns of the cookies beautifully, and provides a contrast with the bright ribbons.
